Students may only apply for a refund within the period of 30 days from enrolment and will forfeit an administration fee of \$500. Please see Refund Policy in the Student Handbook available at www.mwei.edu.au • Students must enrol in at least one module per semester to maintain active enrolment in the course. Modules have end dates each Semester after which, if work is not completed, will be recorded as a fail. Students will need to re-enrol and pay the Module fee again. Any work completed to a satisfactory standard before this time, may be credited upon re-enrolment. A pass mark of 65% is required for all modules, assessments and examinations. • In some circumstances, students may request an extension or deferral of up to one (1) year of the course duration. • Students must attend all workshops required for the relevant Module. If workshops are not offered in their State within their period of enrolment, students will need to travel to attend the required workshops to complete a Module. • The Montessori professional experience component must be undertaken in an approved Montessori or other classroom as per Study Guide instructions and must have a qualified Montessori supervisor. • A working with children clearance (or equivalent) and proof of COVID-19 vaccination (as required by state regulations and individual premises) will need to be provided before undertaking professional experience, classroom observations and face-to-face workshops. • Students must read the Montessori Institute COVID-19 Safety plan and complete a Self-Assessment form within 24 hours of workshop or professional experience attendance, if required. • I understand that changes to course requirements may be necessary, to meet current regulatory requirements as set by statutory, accreditation or government bodies. • Examination fees are paid separately at the time of sitting examinations. • Students will not be graduated if there are fees, library loans or monies outstanding.
