Module enrolments are not refundable or transferable to another person or institution. Modules have end dates each Semester after which, if work is not completed, will be recorded as fail. Students will need to re-enrol and pay the module fee again to complete it. Any work completed to a satisfactory standard before this time, may be credited upon re-enrolment. A pass mark of 65% is required for all assessments.  In some circumstances, students may request an extension or deferral of up to two months of the module duration.  It tudents must attend all workshops required for the relevant module. If workshops are not required in their state within their period of enrolment, students may need to travel to attend the required workshops to complete a module.  The Montessori professional experience component must be undertaken in an approved Montessori classroom as per Study Guide instructions and must have a qualified Montessori upervisor.  The working with children clearance (or equivalent) and proof of COVID-19 vaccination (if required by state regulations and individual premises) will need to be provided before undertaking rofessional experience, classroom observations and face-to-face workshops.  The tudents must read the Montessori Institute COVID-19 Safety Plan and complete a Selfsessessment form within 24 hours of workshop or professional experience attendance, if required, tudents will not receive their module certificate if there are fees or library loans outstanding.
